- 1) Intro to Psychology is a prerequisite for Statistics.
Statistics is a prerequisite for Research Methods.
Research Methods is a prerequisite for the seminars.
- 2) Most of the seminars have a specific, corresponding 200-level prerequisite. For example, in order to take the Seminar in Social Psychology (PSY 370), a student needs to first take Social Psychology (PSY 230).
- 3) Students may repeat a seminar and apply it to the major provided that the topic has changed. However, in order to complete the major, students must complete at least two seminars with different course numbers.
- 4) Research Methods and all seminars must be taken in Goucher's Psychology Department. Statistics, if taken elsewhere, must have an appropriate lab component focusing on computer applications, and must be approved by the department chair.
