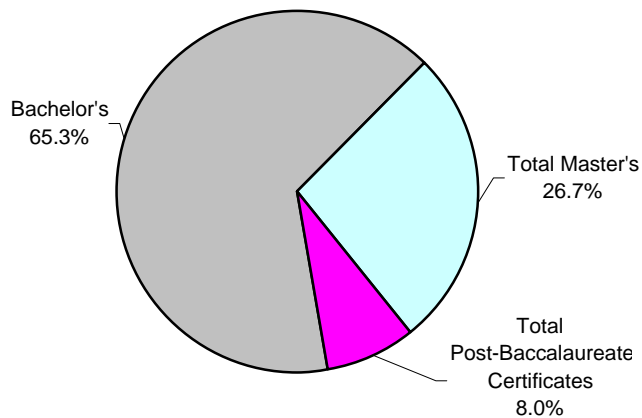

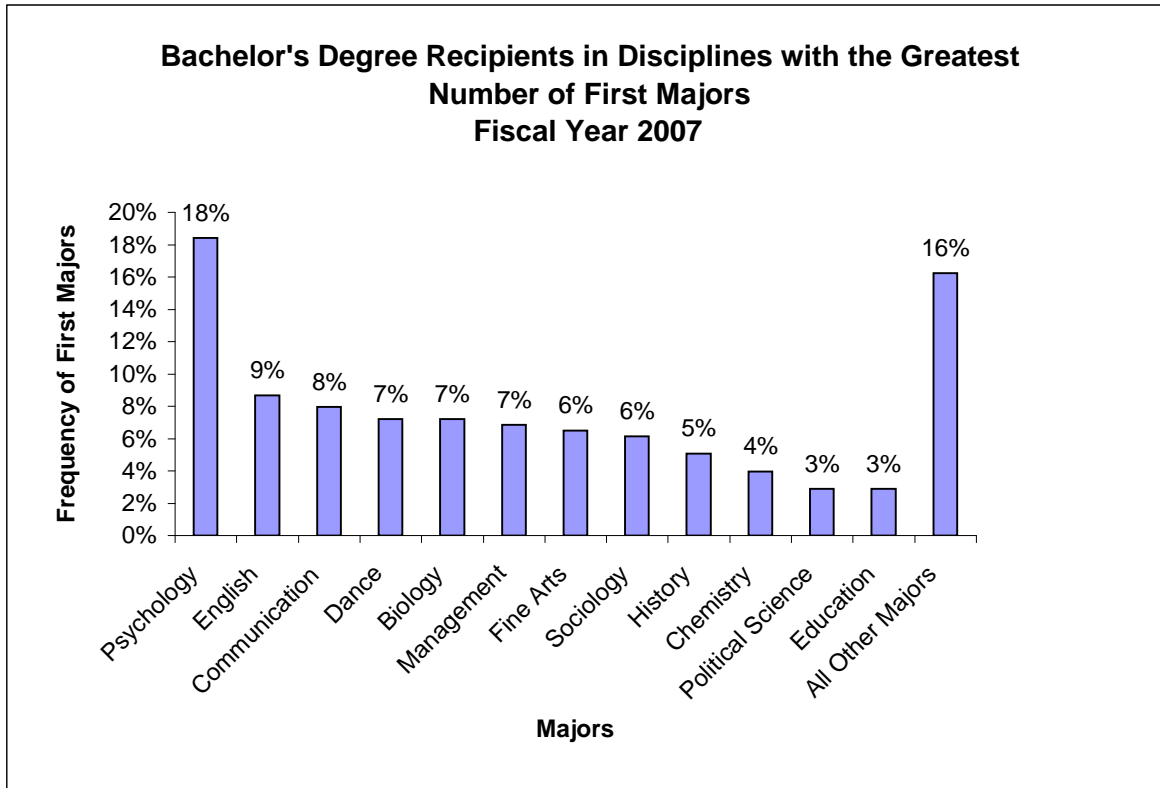

Fiscal Year 2007**



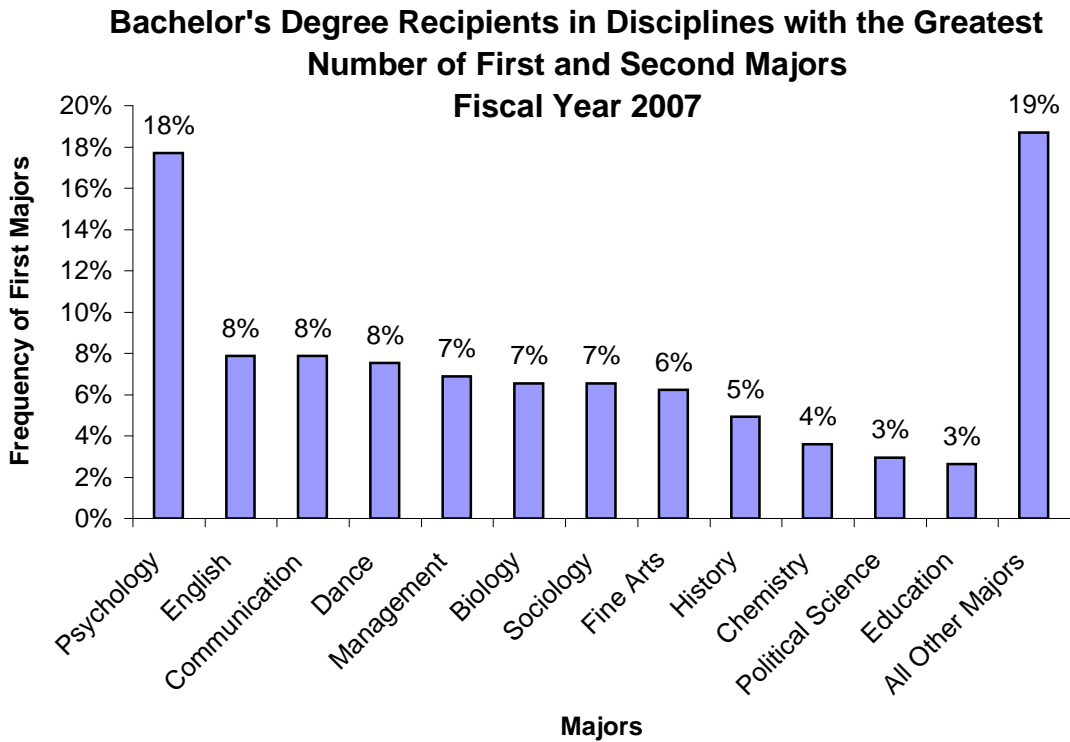

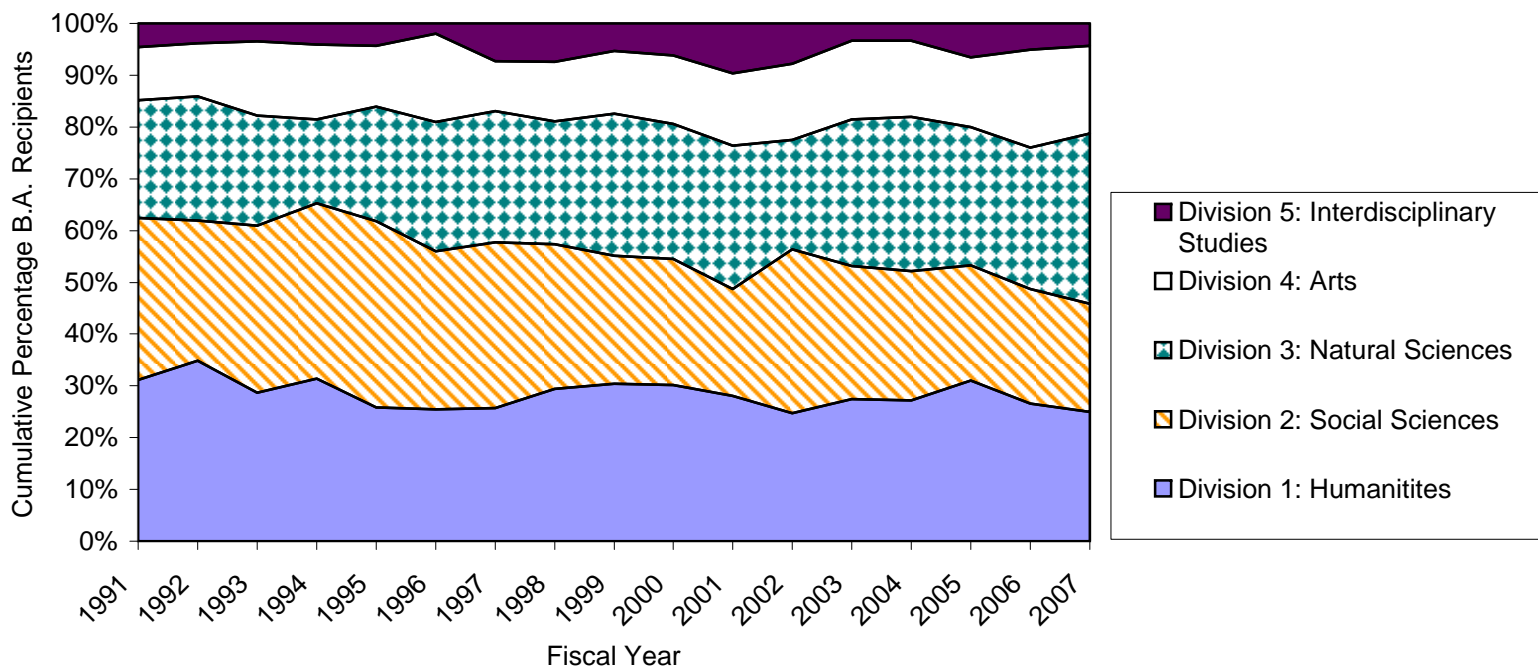

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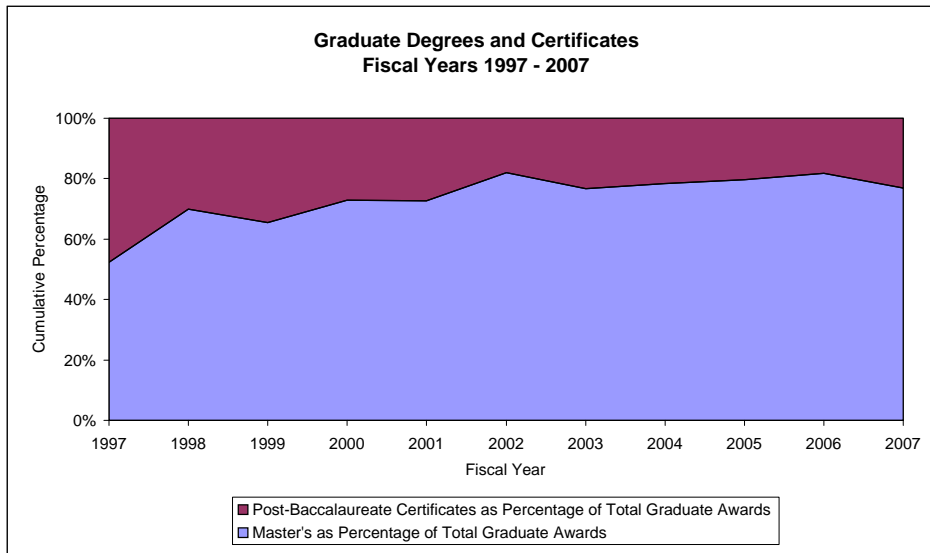
**Percentage of Bachelor's Degree Recipients by Division

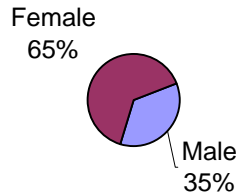

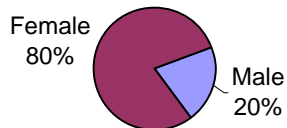

Fiscal Year 2006**

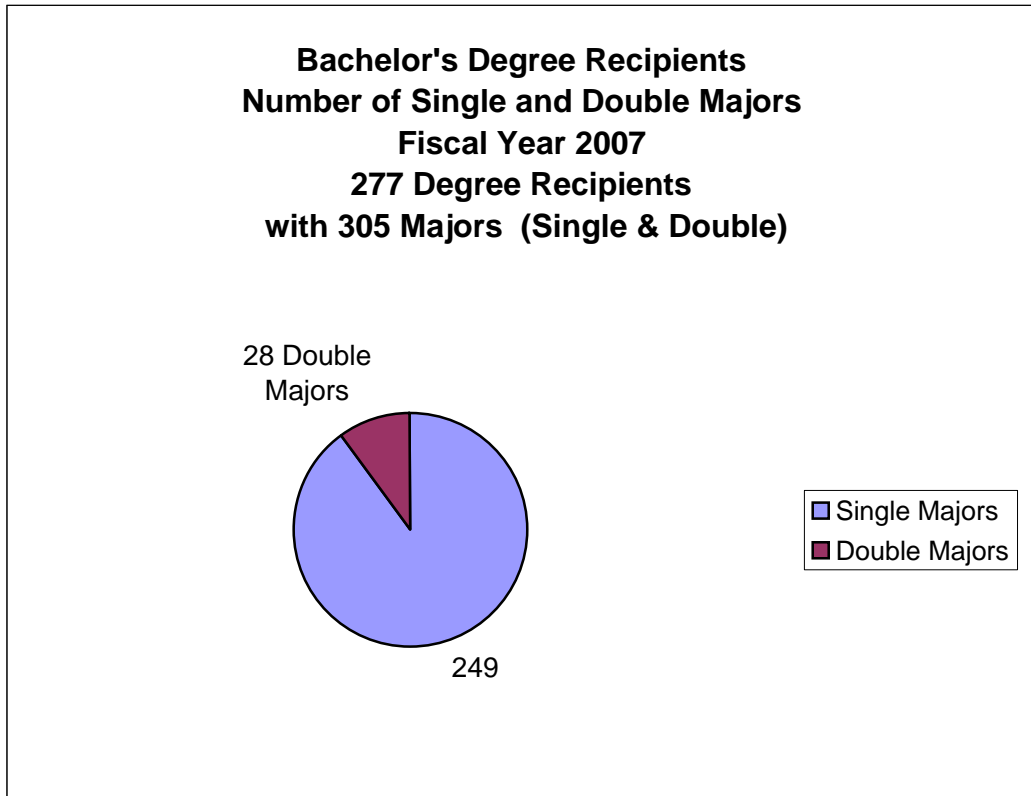


**Master's Degree Recipients by Gender

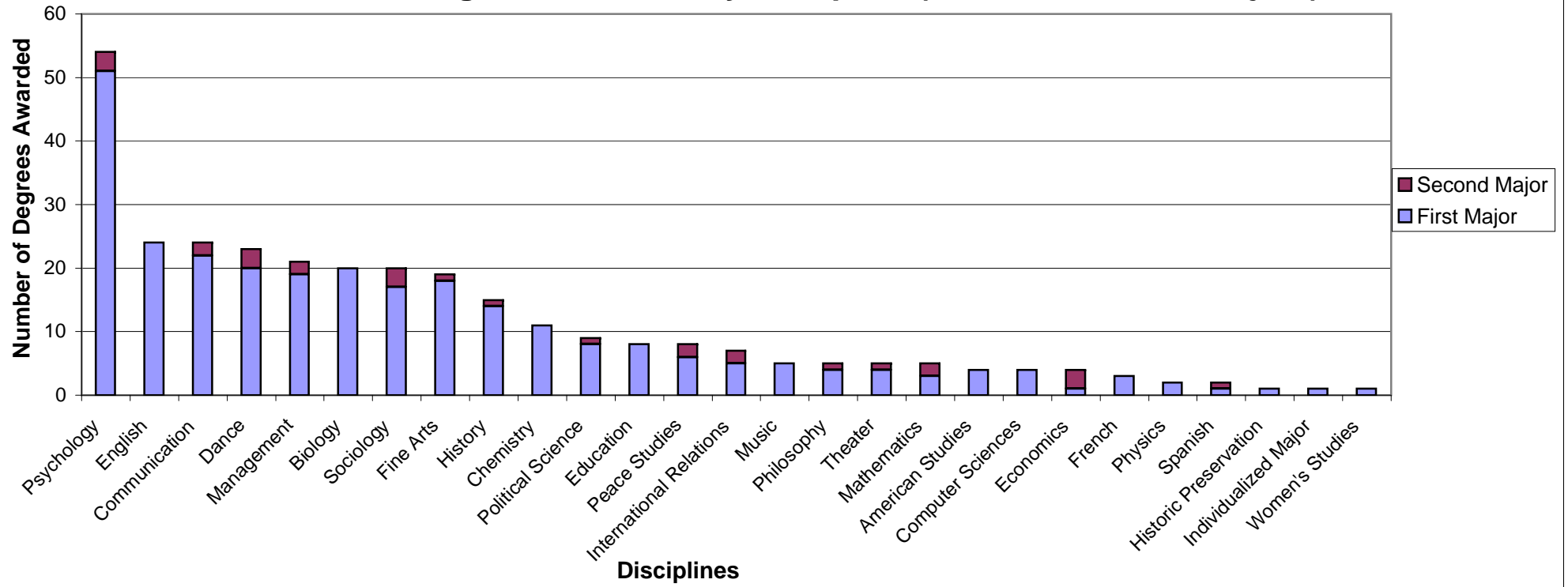
