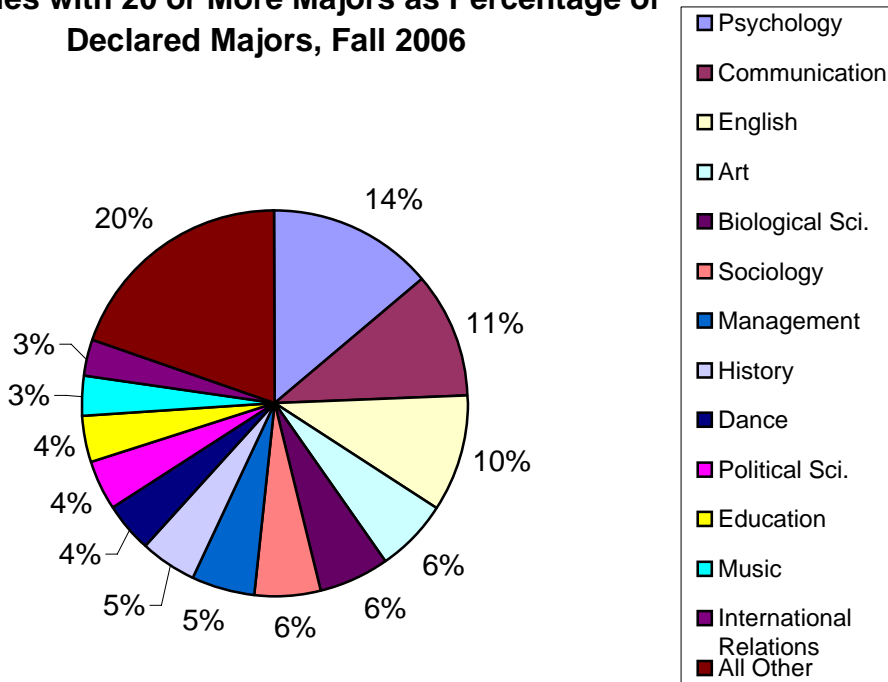

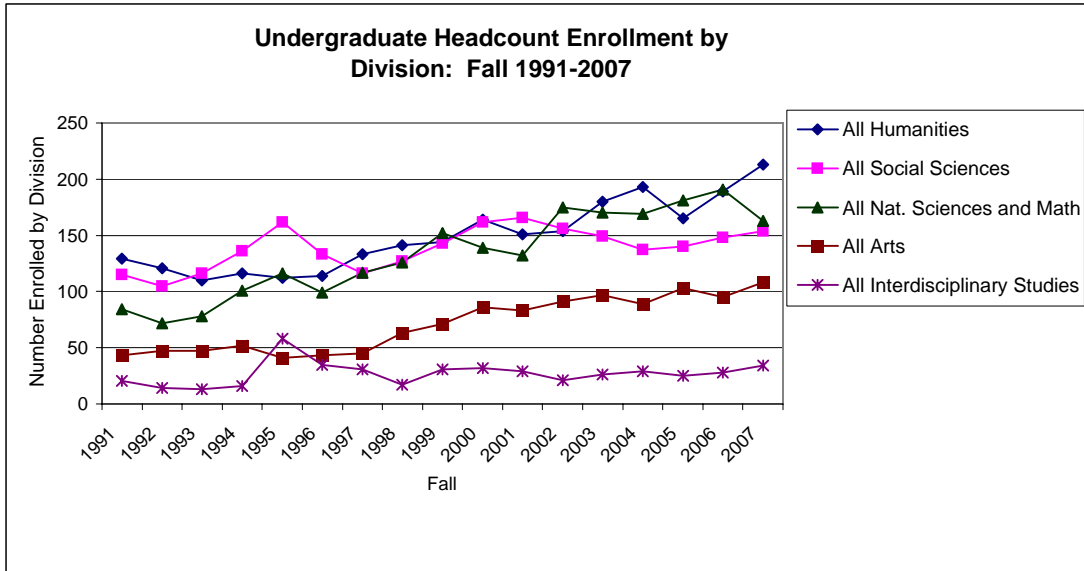

Undergraduate Primary Major (Headcount) by Division, Fall 1991-2007

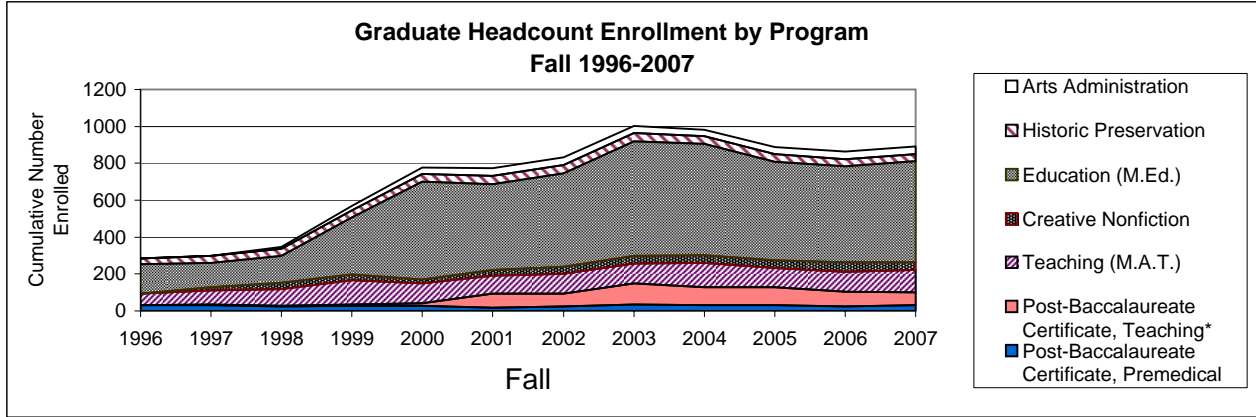

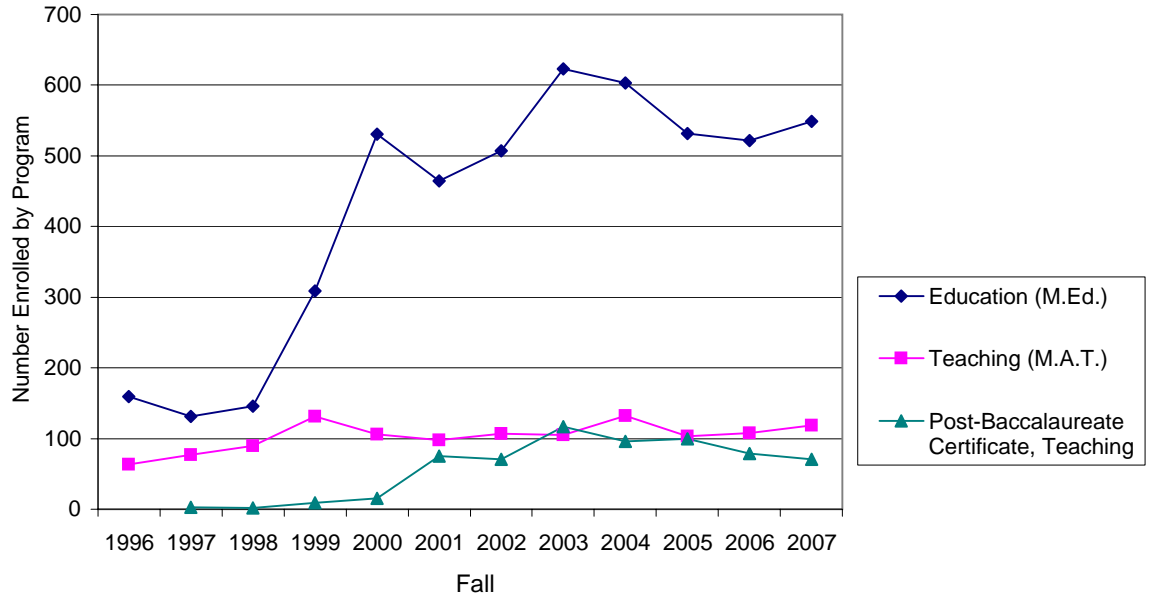

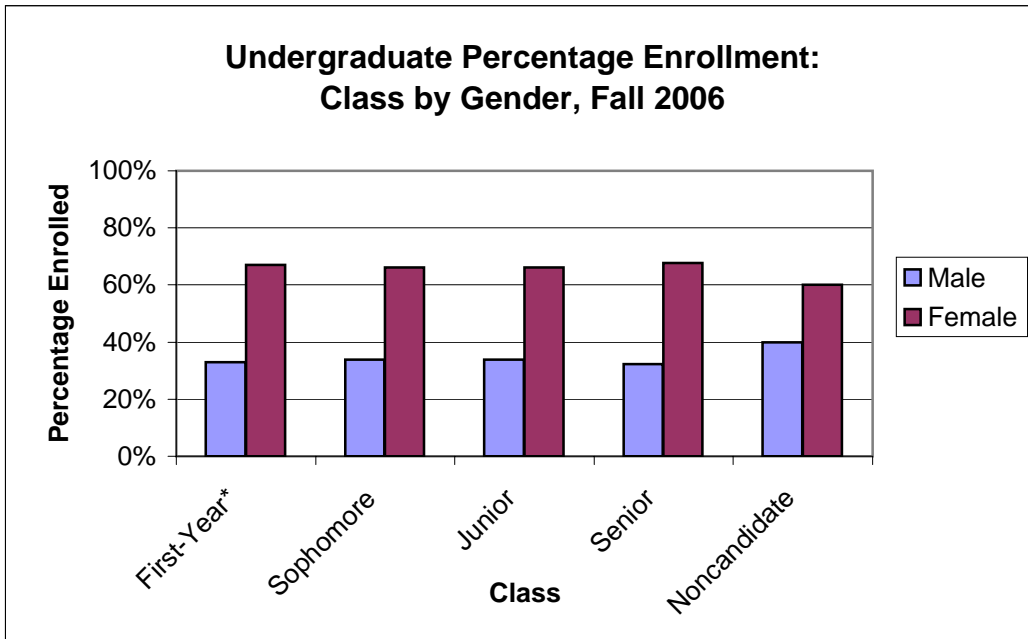
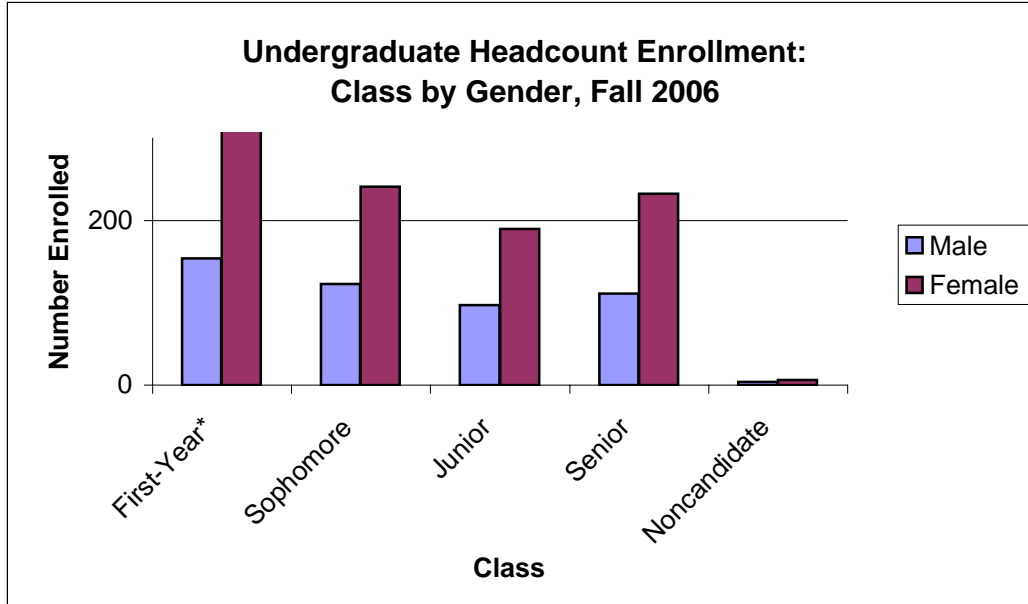


Headcount Enrollment: Graduate Programs in Education Fall 1996-2007



Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment: Class by Gender, Fall 2007

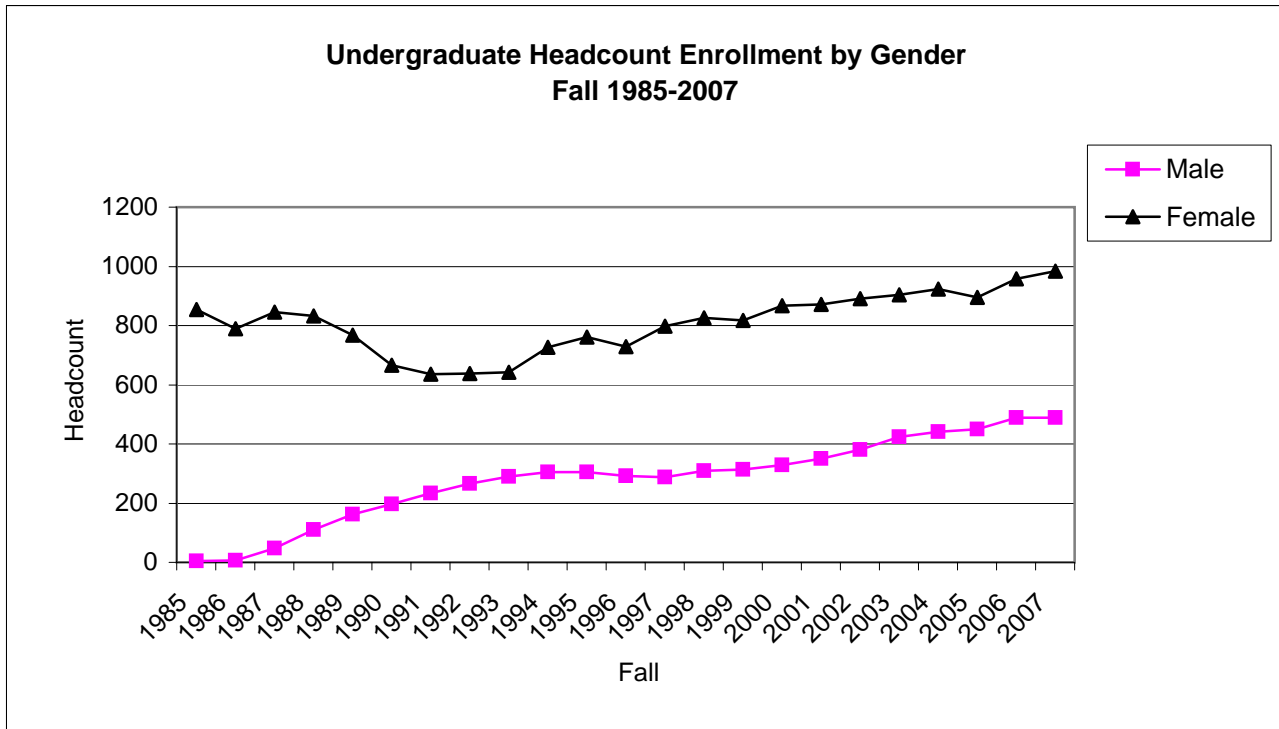

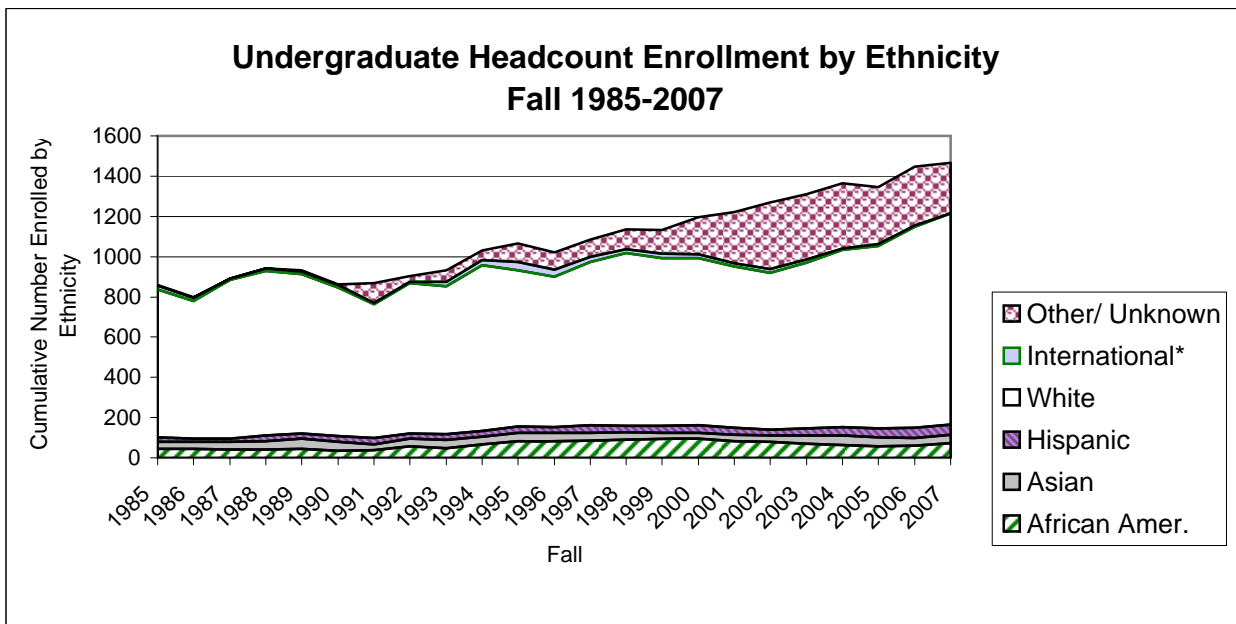

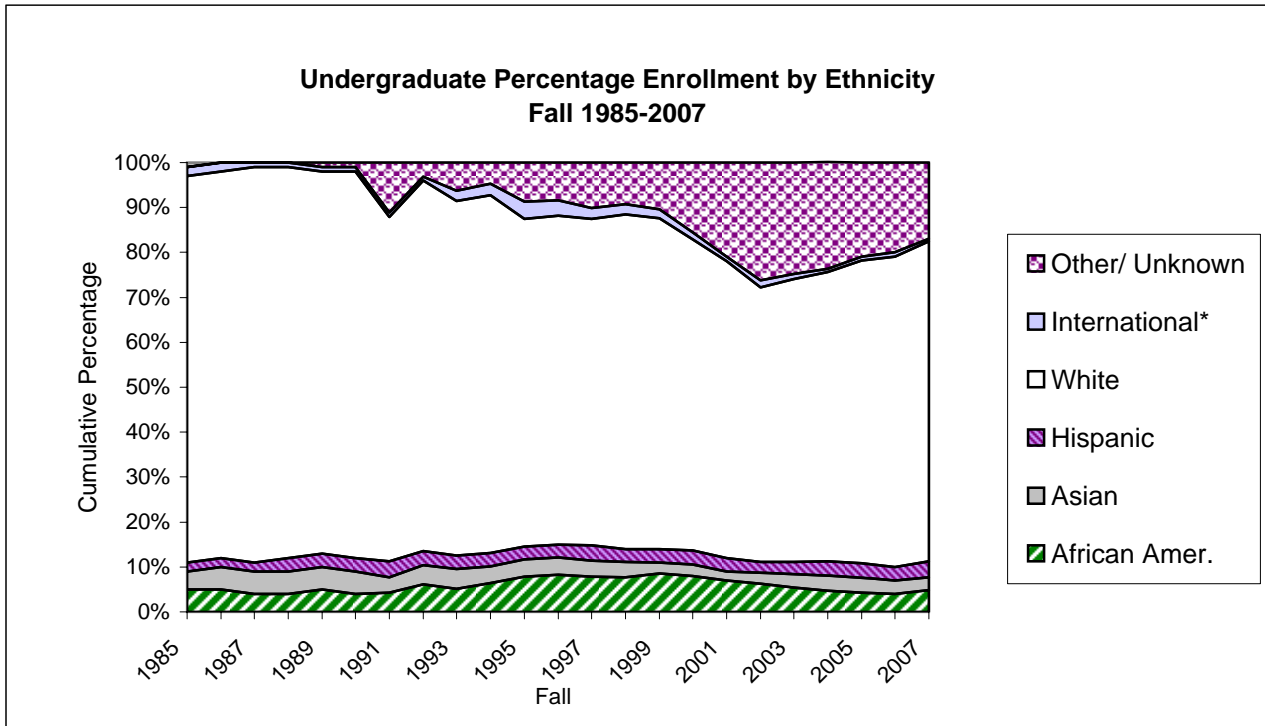

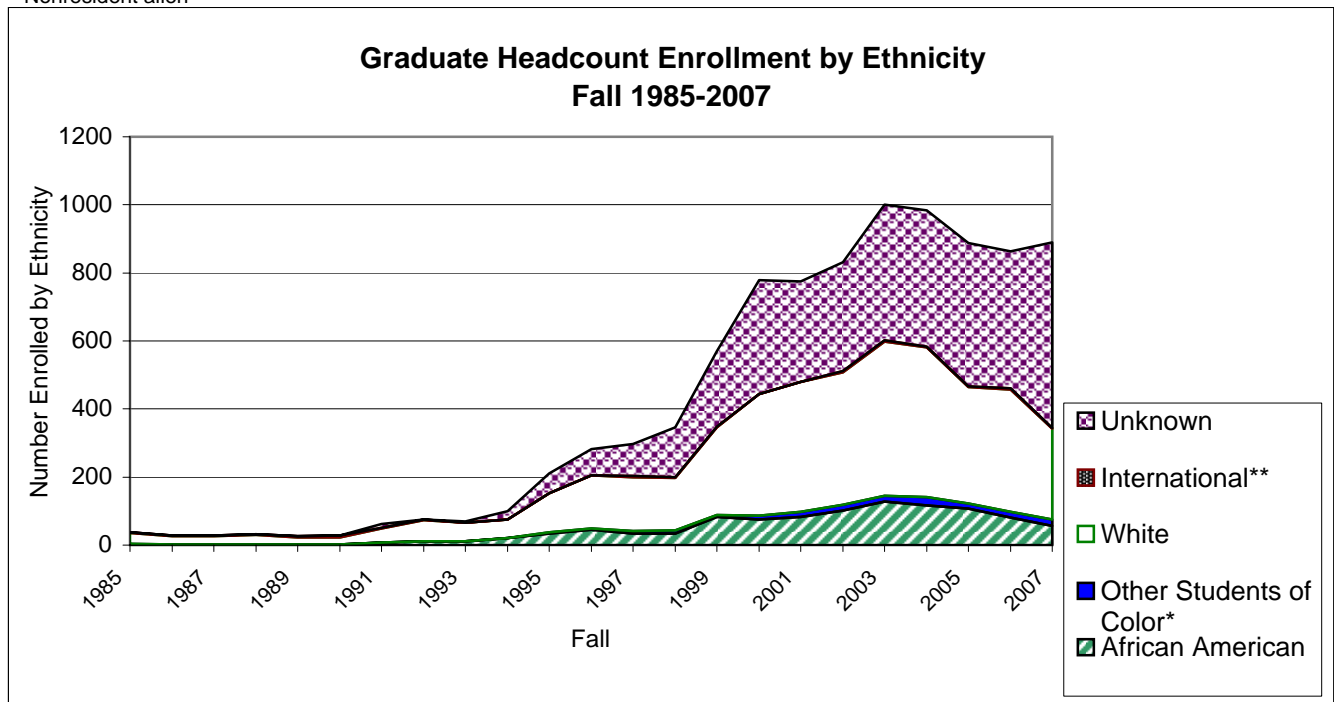

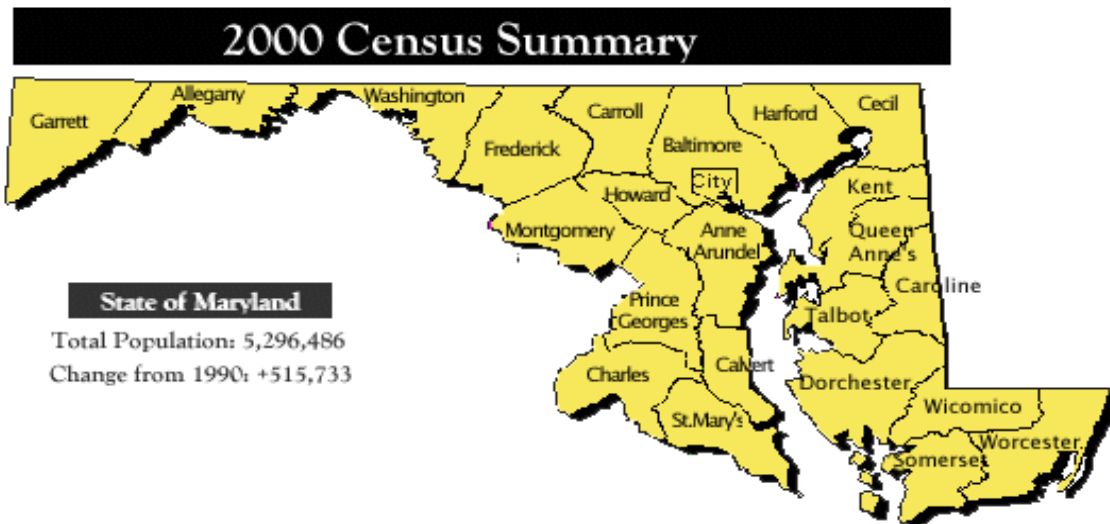
