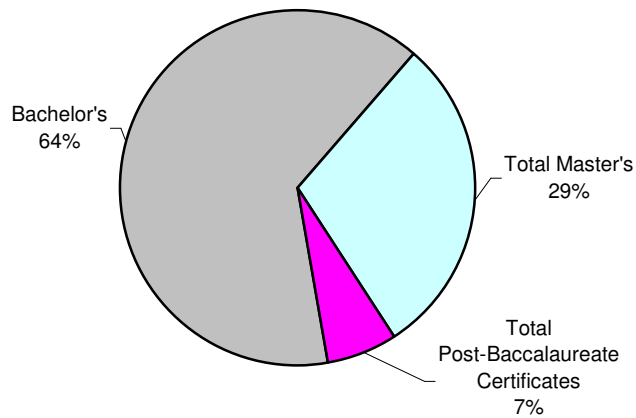

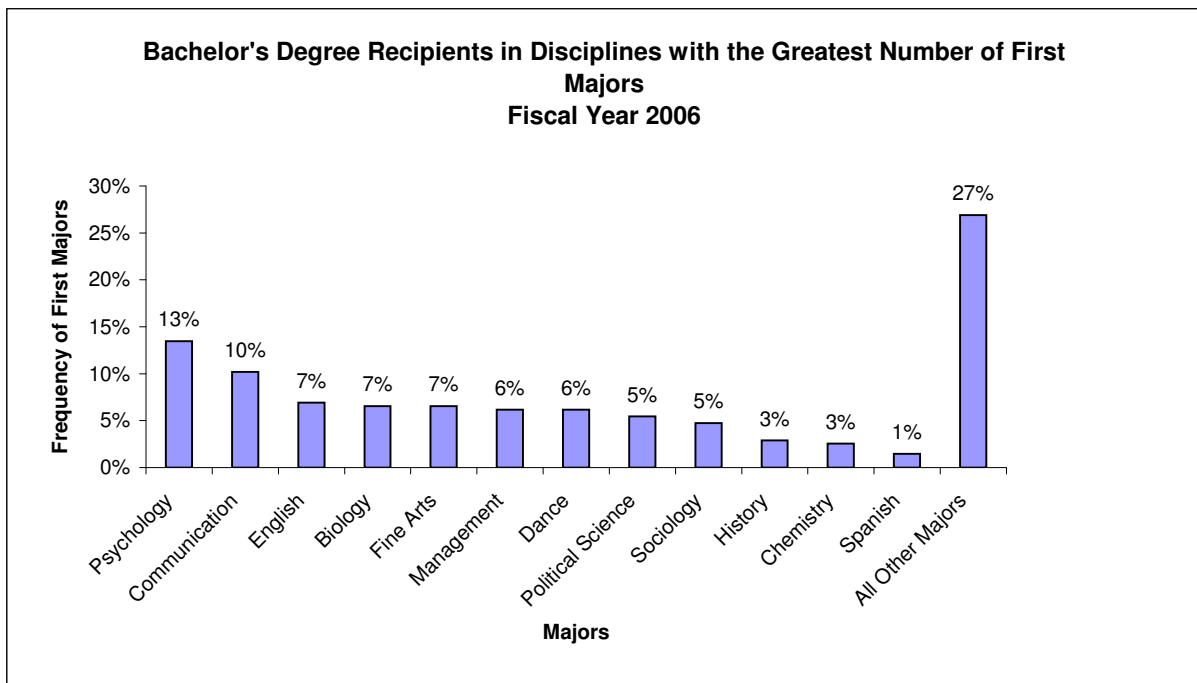

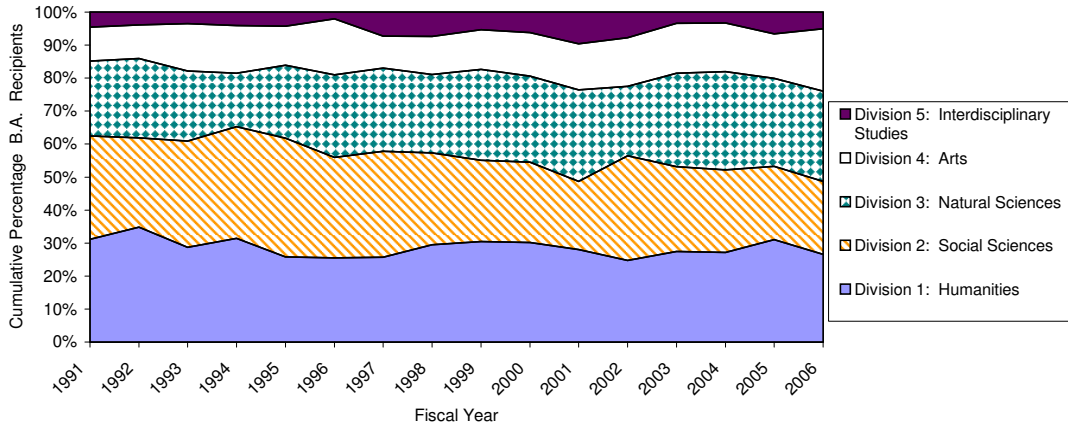

1991-2006**

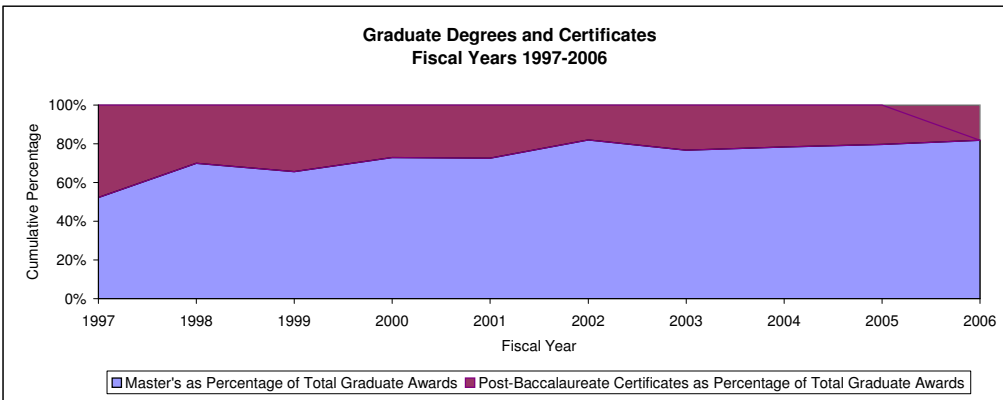

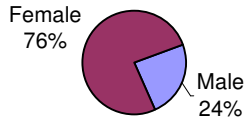

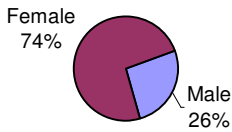
**Bachelor's Degree Recipients by Gender

Fiscal Year



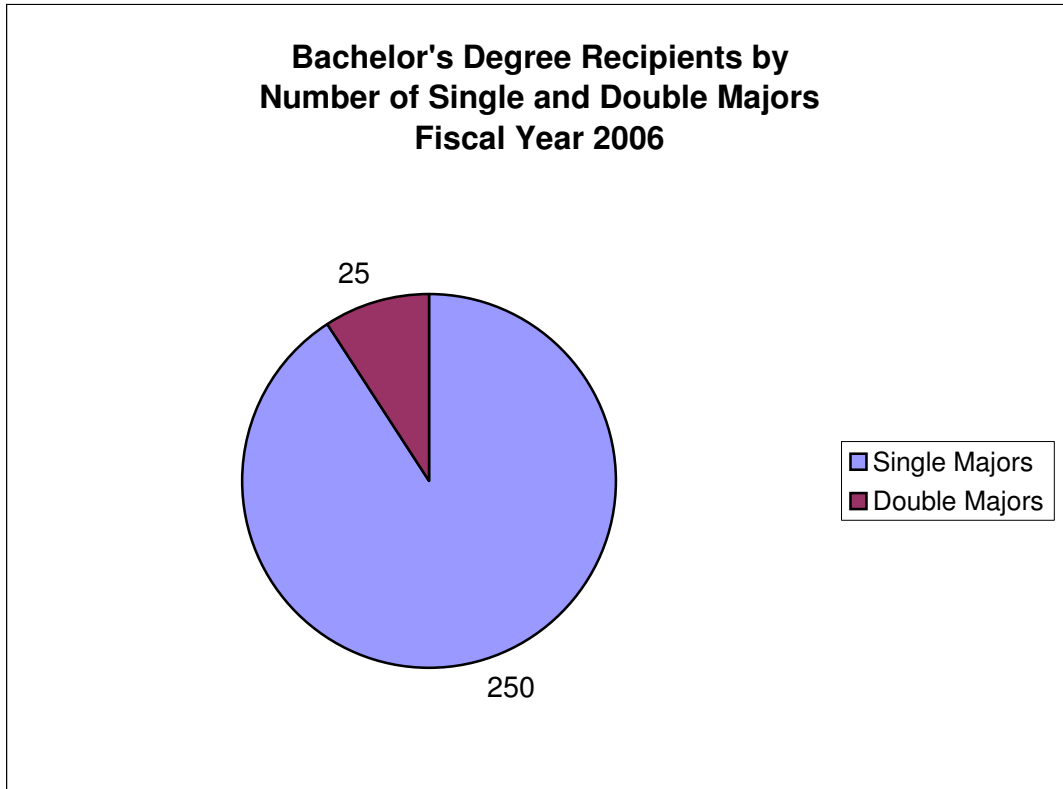
**Master's Degree Recipients by Gender

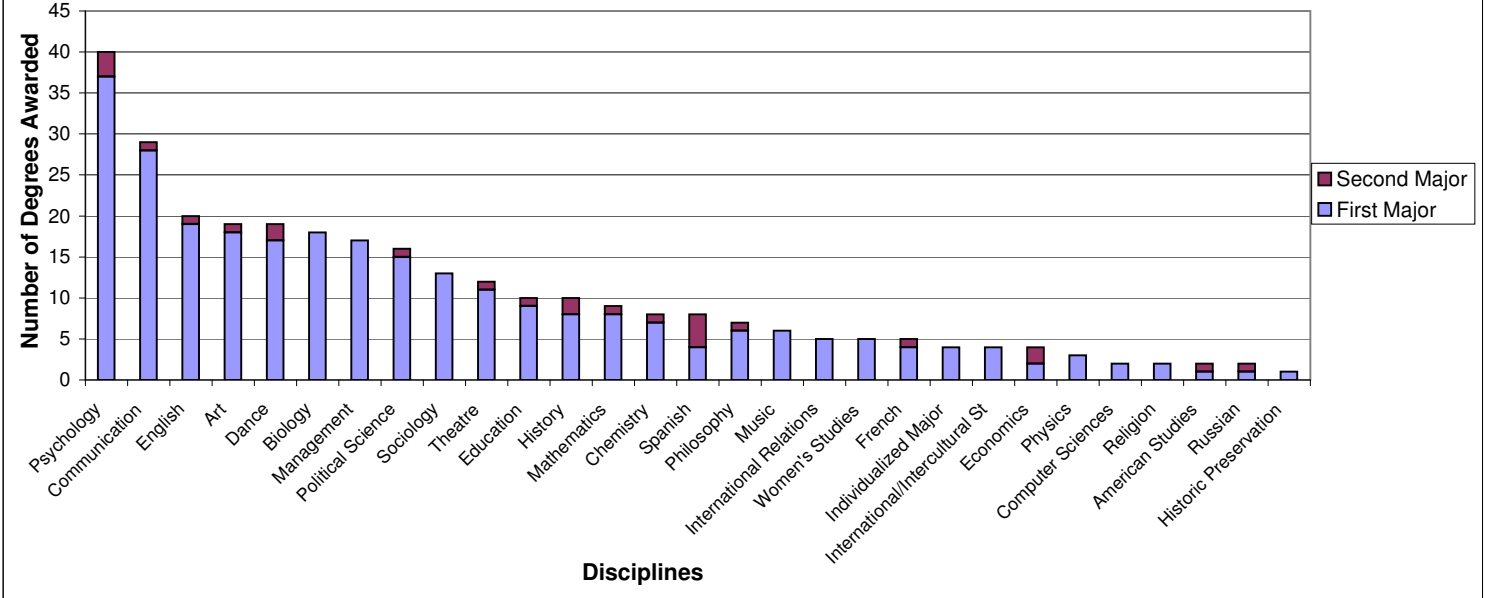
