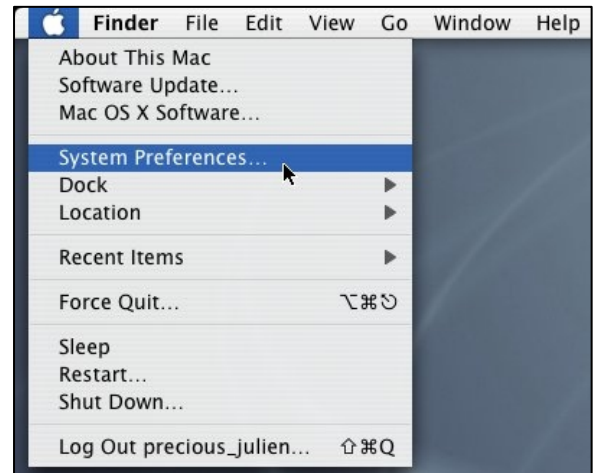


## Using Renew DHCP Lease for Macintosh 10.3 or Higher

If you need to force DHCP to renew its lease OR just simply get a lease, use the Renew DHCP Lease feature. You would only use this utility if you were not able to access the Internet.

Click on the **Apple** menu on the desktop and select **System Preferences...**



Once the System Preferences window appears click on the **Network** icon at the top.

The network settings will appear. Double-click on **Built-In Ethernet** to bring up the network card configuration. Make sure that **Using DHCP** is selected for the Configure field and then click the **Renew DHCP Lease** button.
