The PLs meet weekly for staff meetings. An intensive training will occur a few days before the spring semester begins. All training and meetings are mandatory. Participating in training will not guarantee students a position as a peer listener. Applicants must understand these parameters and be willing to make at least a year (two semesters) commitment to being a PL.

Applications may be reviewed by a group of staff members and current peer listeners.
