

Based upon data provided by the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) and your grade level, the Department of Education has determined that you may have received a total amount of undergraduate student loans that is close to or equal to the loan limits established for the federal loan programs. Therefore, your eligibility for additional student loans may be limited.

The financial aid office will review your Stafford loan borrowing history to determine your remaining Stafford loan eligibility for this academic year. Once the review is completed, you will be notified of your Stafford loan eligibility.

At this time, there isn't a form you need to submit. The "Lifetime Loan Limit" document is just an informative message to you.
