Guidelines for Native Speakers of a Foreign Language and Contacts for Language Courses at Nearby Institutions

Note: Only Johns Hopkins University will accept freshman Goucher students. Sophomore standing will be required for other institutions other than JHU.

Guidelines

- 1) Send a letter or email to the Chair of the Modern Languages Department informing of your language of choice (by the end of your freshman year), along with a detail plan to complete your study of that language. Be aware that in some instances you will have to complete the last intermediate language course offered at that institution (two courses of 3-credits each), or a total of 12 credits (whatever applies).
- 2) Please, contact one of the professors who teach the language of your choice.
- 3) If you have some experience with that language, request a placement test and ask that the results be send to me to update your files. Send a copy to your advisor as well.
- 4) Italian 110 will be offered at Goucher starting Fall, 2005.
