ABOUT

Named in honor of Jewell Robinson—actor, writer, producer, and the first African American student admitted to Goucher College—the annual Jewell Robinson Dinner brings together members and friends of Goucher's Black and African American community in the spirit of celebration, reflection, and fellowship.

This program Attracts approximately 150 attendees via in person and virtual event options.. More than 40% of guests are alumnae/i, 20% visitors, 30% current students, and 10% staff and volunteers.

IMANI FUND

In addition to an annual gathering celebrating our Black and African American community, this event is a fundraiser benefiting The Imani Fund. Since 2003, all Goucher students are required to study abroad to enhance their cross-cultural understanding. The Imani Fund assists Goucher students in their global experience providing financial support covering costs associated with this formative experience.







Marguerite Barland Award

Since 2015, the Marguerite Barland '60 Merit Award has been presented annually in honor and celebration of our first African American graduate, Marguerite Barland.

This award celebrates one or more alumni who in their professional and private lives have significantly contributed to the diversity of our campus community though leadership—as mentors, role models, volunteers, or philanthropic supporters of the college.

Last year, Candace Chance '10, M.A.C.S. '12, was presented with the 2024 Marguerite Barland '60 Merit Award. Chance attended Baltimore City College High School and Goucher College, where she majored in biology and received an M.A. in cultural sustainability. Chance has helped BCIITY raise nearly \$2 million within five months and is currently leading the organization's creation of a community-owned data cooperative. In 2021, she was named one of *The Daily Record's* Leading Women 40 under 40, as well as the 2022 recipient of the first Harriet Tubman Freedom award.
