At Goucher, we focus on student learning. Our faculty members include critically acclaimed writers and nationally recognized scientists, historians, and scholars. They're supportive, but academically demanding, too. Our average class size is only 17 students—this ensures you'll receive personal attention.

Goucher provides a broad-based education with an opportunity to earn a bachelor's degree in 33 majors or one of 10 master's degrees. We believe in testing ideas and theories through hands-on research and experiential learning, such as internships, study abroad, and service-learning programs.

You can choose to participate directly in research with faculty. You may even publish before you graduate.

Goucher students have a global perspective. Many of them come to us because we require them to study abroad. So you'll be surrounded by students who are curious about other cultures.

You'll have a number of artistic and cultural opportunities, too: You can act in a play, join the student orchestra or another musical group, or dance with one of the best college programs in the United States.


More than 70 percent of our students also participate in service-learning, or volunteer, programs. They are out in the community putting their education into action.

Goucher's focus on relationships and on student interests and individuality was what made the college stand out to Zumrad Kabilova.

"In my country, if I were to go [to university], I would just study physics and math and wouldn't be able to take other classes," she says. Goucher was different. "Even if you are taking science, you can still take dance or art classes. That was very appealing to me."

Zumrad also credits her supportive professors, who inspired her each day.

"I really do like the professors; I don't think I'd be where I am without them ... My professor kept pushing me and talking to me about my future and what my plans were. She was actually one of the reasons I got my internship with NASA."

Zumrad graduated in 2016 with a bachelor's of arts degree. She has since entered a Ph.D. program at the University of Michigan-Ann Arbor in electrical engineering.



Join Our Community

It's easy to apply to Goucher.

- 1) Apply online through the Common Application.
 - 2) Submit the following supplemental materials:
 - \$55 application fee or waiver
 - essay portion of the application
 - secondary school transcript (first-year student) or official university transcript (transfer)
 - secondary school adviser report (first-year only)
 - official course descriptions (transfer only)
 - academic teacher/professor recommendation (English, math, science, foreign language, or social studies)
 - International Student Financial Aid Application – Your ISFAA must show at least \$30,000 in expected support for educational expenses
 - Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) results for non-native English speakers (requirement waived if English was the instruction language at your secondary school)
 - Or International language Testing System (IELTS) exam with a minimum score of 28 and with no subsection lower than 7.0.
- We're test-optional. You can submit the SAT or ACT if you choose.*

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

- **Ambassador Scholarship Program**—Annual award of up to \$25,000 (only for international students)
- **Dorsey Scholars Program**—Annual award of \$5,000 for those who have demonstrated exceptional leadership abilities
- **Fine and Performing Arts Scholarships**—For outstanding student artists
- **Other merit funding**—No special application needed for consideration
