 Only courses that satisfy program requirements can be certified. There are some limitations on repeated courses. Tuition & Fees will be pro-rated when reported to the VA if a course cannot be certified for any reason.
 Your estimated VA benefits will NOT appear on your billing statements until the payment is received and processed by the Billing Office. It is the student's responsibility to follow up with the billing office if actual payments do not match estimates.
 You may continue to receive e-mail notices from the Goucher Billing Office if a balance is due on your student account. It does not necessarily mean that there is an issue with your VA benefit. The VA takes an average of 8 weeks to process payments.
 If you withdraw from a course after certification, you must notify our office and the Veterans Administration. The law prohibits payment of veterans' benefits for a course from which a student withdraws. This may result in the VA requesting that you give money back for a course that was paid for, but not completed. For students using Chapter 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill benefits, withdrawing from a course could cause a recoupment of your housing allowance (BAH).
 Upon exhaustion of your VA benefits, you are solely responsible for paying any balance due to Goucher College. Students may also submit a FAFSA and ask about traditional financial aid resources if any VA benefits have exhausted.
 Calculation of any benefits is determined by the VA. Goucher can provide <b>estimates only</b> .
 The VA calculates housing allowance and rate of pursuit based on specific course beginning and end dates and online vs. in- person classes. If some classes are online or not for the entire term, then this means your VA rate of pursuit may be different than your enrollment status for academic, billing, or regular financial aid programs. <b>This applies most specifically to students in</b> graduate degree programs.
 A VA Benefits form needs to be completed every semester in order to be certified. This form should be completed when you are confident of your schedule and should be submitted no later than the end of the drop period for the term. You are required to report any changes to your schedule after submitting your form.
