

## CARES REPORTING

1. An acknowledgement that the school signed and returned the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution used—or intends to use—at least 50 percent of the Cares Act funds received for emergency grants to students.

**Goucher College signed and returned the Certification and Agreement. Goucher assures that the institution intends to use at least 50 percent of the Cares Act funds received for emergency grants to students.**

2. The total amount of funds a school received—or will receive—from ED.

**Goucher College will receive \$1,575,324 from ED, of which \$787,662 will be for emergency grants for students.**

**The amount of emergency grants distributed to students as of the posting is \$764,600.**

6. The method(s) used to determine which students received the emergency grants and how much they received.

**Goucher College used a need-based and application approach.**

**We gave 82 Pell Eligible graduating students \$1,900. We gave the remaining 327 Pell eligible students \$1,400. We gave 89 students with an EFC under \$10,000 (but not Pell eligible) \$1,000.**

**61 students who completed our CARES application and were deemed eligible (not in the categories above) received \$1,000. 2 students who completed our CARES application and were deemed eligible (not in the categories above) received \$500.**

7. Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided to students concerning the emergency grants.

**Student were send an email to their Goucher email letting them know they could log onto their student portal and complete a CARES application.**
