

CRRSAA Act Disclosures

- 1. An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
 - Goucher College signed and returned the Certification and Agreement. Goucher has used and intends to use the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA programs to provide emergency grants to students.
- The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA programs.
 - Goucher College was awarded \$787,662 to provide emergency grants to students.
- 3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA programs as of the date of submission (i.e., as of the initial report and every calendar quarter thereafter).
 - Goucher College distributed \$738,532 to students as of June 30, 2021.
- 4. The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA programs.
 - The estimated number of students eligible to participate in the emergency grant program was approximately 2,080.
- 5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA programs.
 - 398 students received emergency grants under the CRRSAA programs as of June 30, 2021.
- 6. The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the CRRSAA programs.
 - The College used a need-based and application approach.

The need-based approach focused on undergraduate students with an Expected Family Contribution under \$10,001.

The application approach was used to determine financial assistance to support Summer housing and food or other appeals.

Students that met the financial need prerequisites defined above were notified by email of the availability of a CRRSAA grant. Any additional students that contacted the school for financial assistance were encouraged to write an appeal.
