Duties and responsibilities of a student fundraiser include, but are not limited to:

- Call alumnae/i, parents, and friends of Goucher college to ask for a gift to the Greater Goucher Fund (current priorities) and other funds and thank them for previous gifts
- Establish and continue relationships with alumnae/i, parents, and friends of Goucher College
- Inform alumnae/i, parents, and friends about campus news and events
- Send thank you e-mails and letters to donors of the college
- Accurately update and record information
- Maintain an extraordinary level of confidentiality inside and outside the job
- Other duties as assigned

- Excellent telephone communication skills
- Highly motivated
- Dedication towards maintaining and improving Goucher College
- An ability to work well as a team
- Personable, pleasant, professional, and poised
- Able to serve as an ambassador for the school

- Desire and willingness to learn
