### AGREEMENT FOR ENROLLMENT -

The Agreement made this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, between Goucher College, hereinafter called College, and \_\_\_\_\_, hereinafter called Student, shall be binding on all parties upon execution.

In consideration of the sum of **Five Hundred Dollars** (the "Enrollment Deposit"), the College agrees to reserve a place in the aforementioned graduate program for the Student for the upcoming academic year. This reservation is conditioned upon the acceptability of final credentials for admission of which the graduate program shall be the sole judge. This deposit is nonrefundable and will be credited to the first semester tuition.

#### CONDITIONS

The following conditions shall govern the Student's enrollment at the College during all semesters in which the student is enrolled in the graduate program.

- 1. Conduct.** The Student is expected to follow all policies and requirements of the College and shall cooperate with the College in maintaining standards of conduct and scholarship. Should the Student's conduct not conform to college standards, at its discretion the College may suspend or expel the Student.
- 2. Tuition, Fees and Charges to the Student's Account.** The Student is responsible for all tuition, fees, and charges to the Student's account. Registration and student services fees are non-refundable. The Student acknowledges that the Student's attendance and acceptance of benefits from the College constitute an affirmance and ratification of the obligation to pay for such benefits. The Student may be required to withdraw for failure to make payment as prescribed. The college shall impose a late charge for unpaid tuition, fees and charges to the Student's account after the date on which payment is due. Fees and charges cover the entire semester and are due and payable whether or not the Student chooses to remain enrolled. The Student agrees to reimburse the College for collection agency fees, attorney's fees, and all other costs and expenses incurred in collection efforts which may be based on a percentage of the debt, should charges not be paid when due.  
**Note:** The terms "tuition" and "fees" include mandatory charges based on the student's course registration, and the term "charges to the Student's account" includes all expenses incurred at the bookstore, health center, library, and all other facilities extending credit or authorized to charge the Student accounts; as well as health insurance fees, parking fees and fines, fines assessed for damage to College property, and all other charges assessed by the College.
- 3. Student Account Credit.** Students will automatically be refunded any credit balance on their account resulting from Federal loan and other Title IV funds posted to their account that exceed tuition and required fee charges. Refunds will be issued by the 14<sup>th</sup> day following the credit balance appearing on the account. If a Student account has a credit balance due to an overpayment by a source other than federal financial aid, the credit will remain on the account to be applied toward future charges, or the Student may submit a written request to the College billing office for a refund of the credit balance. Any credit amount remaining on the account, upon completion of the program, will be refunded to the Student.
- 4. Liability.** The College is not responsible for the personal property or motor vehicles of its Students. It is recommended that the Student seek out proper insurance for possessions of considerable value.
- 5. Withdrawal.** Withdrawal from the College, whether voluntary or at the request of the College, does not exempt the Student from payment in full for charges incurred during that academic semester or previous semesters.
- 6. Governing Law.** Regardless of the place or places of execution or performance of this Agreement, the parties expressly agree that this Agreement shall be governed by Maryland law, and the parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of Maryland courts.
- 7. Binding Effect.** This Agreement shall be binding on the Student and Cosigner (if any) until all of the obligations of the Student and Cosigner have been fully paid or discharged.
