A Post-Master's Cohort Designed for BCPS Teachers

The purpose of this cohort is to develop innovative leaders who demonstrate high level skills in leading change and establishing and sustaining a positive school culture. This 21 credit **post-master's** cohort will focus on instructional leadership including implementation of the College and Career Readiness Standards and Universal Design for Learning. Cohort participants will be cognizant of current thought related to cultural proficiency and school assessment topics.

During a year-long practicum, participants will apply theories and practices from course work in the school environment. This 21-credit post-master's program is a *Maryland-approved program for Administrator 1 certification that also meets the Goucher Professional Development Certificate requirements.*
