

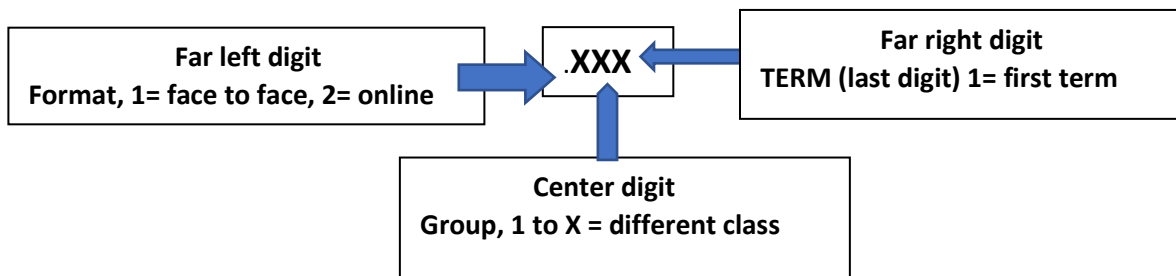

The course listings include courses will be offered face-to-face/hybrid and online. Each student has been affiliated to the school system/private school in which (s) he is working or to Goucher College, if not working in education. The schedule has been modified this year to simplify both registration and billing. In most cases, you will see two sections offered per course; section 001 indicates a face-to-face class and section 002 indicates an online class. Tuition for these courses is no longer determined by section number, but instead by your county affiliation and cohort contract (if applicable). Several school systems have direct billing agreements with Goucher College and courses included in that agreement have been labeled in the schedule that follows as cohort classes; **please check whether your school system has specific delineated courses for direct billing, and refer to the cohort information provided below.**

Current Direct Billing and Cohort Agreements

- Anne Arundel County students see Anne Arundel County eligible courses.
- Baltimore County Educator’s Institute classes (please see the BCPS website to register)
- Harford County students see Harford County eligible courses.
- Cecil County students see Cecil eligible courses.
- Dorchester and Queen Anne Counties students (please contact the county)

All other students not part of one of the cohort agreements listed above may enroll in any graduate education course listed below. Billing is determined by the graduate program tuition and fee schedule, and students must seek reimbursement through their school system, if eligible.

- *Please be advised that Goucher College Graduate Program in Education maintains the option of changing the delivery form from the face to face classroom to an online format should there be a rise in commuting costs, weather or pandemic situations.*

REGISTRATION

The Graduate Programs in Education registration for the Summer 2021 semester will begin at **10 a.m. on Monday, April 12th.**

Goucher Financial Responsibility Agreement:

All students must complete a Goucher Financial Responsibility Agreement before registering, or there will be a hold on the account.

Please click on “Goucher Links” at the top of your myGoucher page and click “Graduate Financial Responsibility Agreement”.

You must e-sign the Agreement, which should immediately lift the hold on your account and allow you to register. If the hold does not immediately lift, try to log out and log back in to your account, or contact helpdesk@goucher.edu.

All registration is online through MyGoucher. Please contact registrar@goucher.edu with questions.

- New students receive a welcome packet within 24 hours of accepting admittance into the graduate programs. If you have received your welcome packet from the admissions department, then please follow those steps to complete registration. If you have not received your welcome packet, please reach out to graduateadmissions@goucher.edu for information on how to register for courses.
- Current students register online through myGoucher (<https://my.goucher.edu>). Current students with an expired password should change their password [here](#). If you encounter any problems with your Goucher login, please contact the helpdesk by emailing helpdesk@goucher.edu or calling 410-337-6322.
 - If using online registration, you will soon receive notification via your **Goucher email** that your E-bill statement is available for viewing. Your E-bill statement will include your semester billing, any balance due, and payment due date. A link is provided to make an online payment.
 - Goucher does not send paper statements. Students will receive an email to their Goucher email address when their statement is ready. Statements are only available online. Your balance due can be paid online by credit card (no Discover Cards) through your MyGoucher account or at the website: www.goucher.edu/webpay. If your balance is not paid by the due date, a billing hold will be placed on your account which will prevent you from registering for a future semester and receiving transcripts. A billing hold will be removed once your balance is paid in full. Past due accounts will be subject to a late payment fee.

EMAIL USAGE

All Goucher students receive a Goucher email upon acceptance to their program. **All official Goucher communication is sent to Goucher email, so it is vital that email is checked often.** Goucher email can be accessed at <https://www.goucher.edu/information-technology/communications/e-mail/>. TUITION

- Tuition is **\$499.00** per credit for the 2021-2022 academic year with a \$65.00 technology fee per credit each semester. Cohort classes have special pricing as designated through the partnerships agreements with local school systems outlined above. Any prior balance must be paid in full before you can register.

ADVISING

Every student has an assigned program advisor to assist in choosing courses each term. TECHNOLOGY STANDARDS

Students in the Master of Education (M.Ed.), Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) or Professional Development Certificate Programs are required to meet a set of technology standards, including an electronic portfolio. Please see pages **20** for complete details.

All online course sessions are asynchronous with synchronous classes as designated. **Online courses are not self-paced, and students must complete assigned work every week.**

PARKING ON CAMPUS

Every student is required to display a parking permit on his/her vehicle while on campus. Permits will be sold by semester (\$50) or by academic year (\$75, for example fall and spring). GRADUATION

If you expect to graduate after the completion of the Summer 2021 semester please contact your [advisor](#) to confirm that you are on the potential graduation list. The Graduate Programs award diplomas 3 times per year, but only have one Commencement ceremony each spring. More information will be provided throughout the Summer term through Goucher emails.

INCLEMENT WEATHER or PANDEMIC PROCEDURES

Technology Requirements

Please read carefully!

All students entering the Master of Education (M.Ed.), Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.), or Professional Development Certificate (PD) Programs are required to meet a set of technology standards and complete an electronic portfolio.

There are three modules that make up the Technology requirements of the State standards. Students must complete these modules OR demonstrate competencies during their standards review.

Module 1: Using Canvas, MS Word, PowerPoint, Excel and the Internet for own scholarship

Module 2: E-Portfolio orientation

Module 3: Using technology for instruction

M.Ed. Technology Requirements:

- There will be a Module 1 session for M.Ed. students who feel their technology skills are weak in Technology Module 1.
- M.Ed. students who feel they are proficient in the use of Module 1 content (Word, Excel, PowerPoint and the internet) will demonstrate the completion of the requirements for Module 1 during ED 605 Research Methods.
- ALL M.Ed. students **must complete** the standards covered in Modules 2 and 3 by attending these two modules as outlined on the next page OR by demonstrating competence. Students are encouraged to complete these modules early in their program.

M.A.T. Technology Requirements:

- There will be a Module 1 session for M.A.T. students who feel their technology skills are weak in Technology Module 1.
- M.A.T. students who feel they are proficient in the use of Module 1 content (Word, Excel, PowerPoint and the internet) will demonstrate the completion of the requirements for Module 1 during the M.A.T. core courses.
- ALL M.A.T. students are required to complete the standards covered in Module 2 prior to their student teaching internship, OR demonstrate competence. Students are encouraged to complete these module/standards early in their program.
- Completion of the Technology Module 3 requirements will occur during the student teaching seminar.

Professional Development Certificate Requirements:

- Modules 1 and 3 are not required for those in the Professional Development Certificate Program.

- ALL students in the Professional Development Certificate Program are required to **complete** Module 2. Students are encouraged to complete the module early in their program.
