

Complaint of Sexual Misconduct, Relationship Violence, and Stalking

Conduct that violates Goucher's Policy on Sexual Misconduct, Relationship Violence, and Stalking (which includes sexual violence and sexual harassment) are not tolerated at Goucher College. Please use this form to report policy violations by any member of the Goucher College community. The information you provide in this form will be kept as private as is reasonably possible. You may make this complaint anonymously and/or only provide details you remember or are comfortable with at this time, but please understand that doing so may limit the college's ability to conduct an effective investigation.

You can receive resources and accommodations via the Title IX Office whether or not the accused person is a member of the Goucher College community. Also, if a member of another college/university community is the accused person, Goucher's Title IX Office can assist you in working with the other institution.

Please note that regardless of what type of complaint you are filing, the Title IX Office or Public Safety can assist you in reporting to the Baltimore County Police Department, or other relevant authority, if desired.

Select the option below for the type of complaint you are making – please read the description or talk to the Title IX Office to understand your choice. Regardless of the type of complaint being made, you are entitled to reasonable accommodations to ensure your safety and access to college programs and activities.

_____ **Report of Policy Violation:** A *report* means you are informing the Title IX Office that an incident has occurred that may be in violation of Goucher College's Policy on Sexual Misconduct, Relationship Violence, and Stalking. While the Title IX Office performs a basic analysis to ensure there is no imminent danger to you or other community members, the office will not contact the accused person(s) without your consent, unless a) there is a serious danger to you or anyone else b) the accused person is a repeat offender or c) if a weapon or drugs other than alcohol were used in an assault.

If appropriate in your case, you have the option to attempt to resolve your report informally. If the informal process does not result in a resolution that is satisfactory to you, you may file a formal complaint later.

_____ I would like to attempt an informal resolution of my report. I understand that the accused person will be made aware that I filed a report with the Title IX Office.

_____ **Formal Complaint under Goucher's Policy:** A *formal complaint* means you are asking the Title IX Office for a formal investigation, in a timely manner, into the reported incident. You should understand that the accused person will be provided with a copy of your complaint and details provided by witnesses we interview. Although we cannot guarantee a particular outcome of a formal investigation, this option can potentially lead to sanctions being imposed against the accused person if the person is found responsible for a policy violation.
