

Smoke-Free Policy Sanctions

All individuals, regardless of their affiliation with Goucher College, are subject to the following sanctions for any violations of the Goucher College Smoke Free Policy.

	Sanction(s)
First Offense	Formal Warning
Second Offense	\$25 Fine
Third Offense (and beyond)	\$50 Fine & referral to student conduct, human resources, or provost for additional disciplinary action

I. NOTES

- A. Any individual observed to be in violation of the Smoke Free Policy by a Goucher College Office of Campus Safety or Office of Residential Life staff member (for students only) will be issued a citation; fines must be paid in the Office of the Vice President and Dean of Students by the deadline provided on the citation.
- B. Any student receiving a citation may contest the violation by submitting a written statement via email to the Associate Dean of Students for Student Development (ADOS). This statement must include a description of the circumstances surrounding the violation, and present an argument for the dismissal of the citation. The ADOS will review the statement, in consultation with the Director of Public Safety and the Director of Residential Life, and render a decision to uphold or dismiss the citation. This process applies only to current Goucher students.
- C. Guests who fail to comply with the Smoke-Free Policy may be removed from campus temporarily or permanently.
- D. Smoking inside any campus buildings constitutes a fire safety violation. These violations are subject to additional disciplinary action.
- E. Individuals failing to complete sanctions may face additional disciplinary action.
